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The best oil is...



An olive oil made in Sacramento with California olives took first place in an informal blind

tasting of 12 olive oils from the United States, Italy, Greece and Spain.

The Bariani Olive Co.'s Extra-Virgin California Olive Oil racked up the most gold-medal points and the most points overall in the tasting, sponsored by the Italian Importing Co. The oil sells for around \$14 for a 750-milliliter bottle and \$8 for a 375-milliliter bottle.

Finishing in a tie for second were Sciabica's Sevillano Variety Fall Harvest Extra-Virgin California Olive Oil from Modesto (\$16 for 750 milliliters), and a bulk Italian virgin olive oil that the store sells to customers who bring their own jugs (\$9.50 per half-gallon).
